REDEVELOPMENT - After a number of years of discussion, in November 2020 we submitted our plan for the demolition of the sanctuary and the erection of a new building that would more adequately enable us to pursue the ministries of the church in supporting the Community we serve.

Rother District Council refused the application on the basis that:

- 1. A Victorian asset would be lost to Bexhill and
- 2. The new building would have a negative effect on the character and appearance of the area.

Having taken expert advice we appealed to the National Planning Inspectorate.

An Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State came to Bexhill on June 15th to hear the submissions from Rother District Council and Beulah and we heard a few days ago that our Appeal was not successful.

However, the Inspector has agreed with us that "the loss of The Sanctuary would be acceptable in the light of the benefits of the scheme". Therefore at present we have established that the demolition of the Sanctuary is acceptable in principle, which is in itself excellent.

If we had NOT appealed we would be stuck with this building and could only proceed by making internal changes.

We now need to review with our Architects what the Inspector calls 'the unsympathetic frontage to Clifford Road' to enable the submission of a revised plan.
