An important note regarding safety - please remember that we very often host vulnerable people including young children here at Beulah. These people use our building knowing that it's a safe space and that they/their children will be safe here.
If you happen to lose something sharp, for example a pair of scissors, a knitting needle, a pin from one of the notice boards... **please make sure you mention it** to any of the group leaders or employees (names and faces are on the notice board at reception desk). It is alarming how easily sharp objects can end up in places one would never expect, purely by coincidence, posing a serious risk to anyone using our premises - especially vulnerable adults and young children.

Volunteering opportunity - Bexhill Foodbank is looking for volunteer drivers to join their team. Driving would primarily be in Bexhill but sometimes you'd head out to Battle or the rural villages.
